

On Sydkoster, the larger of the Koster Islands, you'll hike through a lush landscape of deciduous forests, flower-rich coastal meadows, and long sandy beaches with inviting swimming spots. Surrounding you is Sweden's most species-rich marine area, the Kosterhavet National Park.
