


The Bohusleden trail passes just south of the burial mound

Blomsholm is an intriguing destination featuring some of Bohuslän's most famous ancient monuments. Information panels at the stone ship, the stone circle and the large mound Grönehög provide an interesting background to the region's 2,000-year history. A notable event in 1718 was when Karl XII's Carolinians hauled their boats overland from Strömstad to Fredriksten Fortress. This "Gälarväg" passes through the area. (Blomsholm Manor was established in the 1620s through the consolidation of smaller farms.)

♣ Bench / Rest area

A strategically located ancient fortification that during the migration period had a view over the shipping routes to Blomsholm and Dyne. At the top of the mountain, there is an intriguing feature: the opening to a deep gap. Approach with caution.
