

Kobbungen, located at Singlefjorden north of Strömstad, consists of the peninsula Nordbytången, offering beautiful views over the Hvaler archipelago to the west and Svinesund Bridge to the east. The area features relatively untouched nature, rich flora and fauna and a diversity to explore. In the ravine of Kobbungsbäcken, a lush mixed forest grows as a contrast to the peninsula's rocky pine forest. The area includes several smaller trails with significant elevation changes and dense vegetation.
